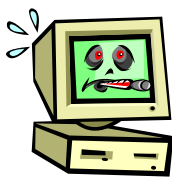
DROP OFF AND PICK UP IN THE K-2 PARKING LOT

SCHEDULE FOR LOCKWOOD**

**Does your child need medical and/or dental care?
Are your kids without health and/or dental insurance?
Are you having difficulty finding a dental provider who will accept new medicaid patients?**

If you answered “yes” to the above, there is care available for your children. The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile provides medical and dental care to children birth -18 years old who do not have insurance or have not been able to access care. This mobile clinic travels the Billings area Mondays through Fridays. It is available to your child wherever it is parked. It will be in Lockwood several days a month. A schedule is available at school in the Family Resource Center, building offices and the nurse’s office. It is also posted on the school website monthly calendars. Call 238-6008 to make an appointment if your child needs care.
